Listening sessions on rulemaking

Colorado legislature recently passed the “Agricultural Workers’ Rights” bill (SB21-087) that will impact agricultural workers in the areas of:

- Wages and overtime pay
- Worker protection
- Access to services
- Limitations on hand weeding and thinning

The Colorado Department of Labor and Employment (CDLE) and the Colorado Department of Agriculture (CDA) are seeking input from ag communities to establish the regulations related to these topics.

Wages, overtime, and worker protection are critical concerns to everyone in the farming and ranching industry. Staff from CDA and CDLE will host a listening session specifically focused on answering questions and gathering the perspective of agricultural workers and agricultural employers.
